Guidelines

Signing the registration form constitutes full acceptance of these rules by the participant. Registration therefore includes the commitment to comply with all the provisions listed here.

1. Participation and Categories

- The competition is open to all floral art enthusiasts.

2. Creation of the Arrangements

- Arrangements must be personally designed and created by the participants, without any external assistance.
- All work must be carried out exclusively on-site, in the spaces provided by the organizers, and within the time limits set by the official program.
- Each participant may submit multiple works, but only one arrangement per category is allowed.
- Workstations are assigned by the organizers and cannot be changed.
- Participants must protect the floor during the creation of their work and clean their assigned area.

3. Materials and Techniques

- All plant materials used, except for succulents, fruit, and vegetables, must be placed in water or in water-saturated supports.
- Plant materials must remain the main feature in all categories; a label will be provided for participants to indicate the title of their work and the plant materials used.
- Artificially colored plant materials may be used with discretion, in categories where permitted.
- Accessories, where allowed, must not be dominant.
- Structural elements and supports must be completely hidden so as not to affect the appearance or natural quality of the arrangement.
- No participant is allowed to remain in the competition area after 12:30.

4. Dimensions and Proportions

- The height of the arrangements must always respect the limits of the exhibition spaces and the guidelines for each category. In particular, for works placed inside niches, exceeding their maximum height is not allowed.

5. Care of the Arrangements During the Exhibition

- Participants must ensure that their work remains in excellent condition for the entire duration of the exhibition.
- They are therefore responsible for any maintenance or replacement of deteriorated plant materials to ensure the compositions remain presentable and intact.

6. Evaluation of the Arrangements

- Arrangements will be judged by a qualified Jury appointed by the organizers.
- Judging will be anonymous.
- Any arrangement not complying with the rules will be disqualified.
- The Jury's decisions are final and cannot be contested or changed.

7. Liability

The organizers are not responsible for any damage, loss, or theft concerning the arrangements, materials, or objects exhibited by participants.
